Romans 15:29 - And I am sure that, when I come unto you, I shall come in the fullness of the blessing of the gospel of Christ.

Notice this phrase once again: ...the fullness of the blessing of the gospel of Christ.

I don't know what that does for you, but it literally jumped off the page of my Bible and right into my spirit. Just think about the possibilities this brings to our lives once it becomes a revelation to us.

Apparently, there is a "blessing" that is associated with or connected to the gospel of Christ.

The word "blessing" means to be endowed with or to be empowered with. In other words, when you and I receive the gospel of Christ, then a special endowment or empowerment comes upon our lives.

You could say that certain attributes or qualities come into our lives that did not exist before.

The Apostle Paul was very much aware of this endowment, or this empowerment and he expected it to manifest in his life everywhere he went.

To him, it's what made the difference between success and failure. In his mind, there could be no defeat if you knew that the "blessing of the gospel of Christ" was operating in your life.

That's why he could boldly declare in the midst of adversity, "I am confident" and "I'm fully persuaded."

You never hear Paul saying, "You never know what God might do." Paul knew what God would do and he knew what this endowment could do and he wasn't afraid to say so regardless of what anybody thought.

No matter what his circumstances were, he knew that this "blessing" was on his life. He knew that this "blessing" could turn any situation around regardless of how impossible it might seem.

Listen to what he says when facing death in a prison cell: Philippians 1:12 - But I would you should understand, brethren, that the things which happened unto me have fallen out rather unto the furtherance of the gospel...

(Message) - .....my imprisonment has had the opposite of its intended effect. That's what happens when "the blessing of the gospel of Christ" is on your life.

God's best is for us to walk in the "blessing of the gospel" to the utmost and to the highest degree.

While meditating this verse, the Holy Spirit gave me this definition of "fullness."

- 1) The state of being complete so that nothing is missing.
- 2) The state of abounding so that nothing is wanted.
- 3) The state of abundance so that nothing is needed

I don't know about you but I've decided that I'm going to walk in the fullness of the blessing.

I think that it is time for us to set our sights higher. Let's stop limiting God and let's move on up to the fullness of the blessing!
